She is a regular speaker and moderator at both national and international conferences, covering topics such as; ultrasound examination in intraocular tumours, UBM and ultrasonic examination of children.

Mr David Sculfor is a Consultant Optometrist with Buckinghamshire NHS Foundation Trust. In 1994, he moved to Stoke Mandeville Hospital to start a new Optometry Department, where his special interests include; biometry, electrodiagnostics and diabetic retinopathy screening. David also established the Bucks Diabetic Eye Screening Programme and has carried out numerous training courses, workshops and conference lectures for the British Association of Retinal Screening (BARS).
